*Some eligibility categories have various resources tests. Deductions and exceptions apply. This is a proxy amount. People with higher incomes may have medical expenses deducted from income calculations to “spenddown” to this level.

Disabled individuals (age 16-64) who are able to work	250% FPL*	\$2,257	

The resource limit is \$10,580. (This limit is adjusted annually.)

Individuals with higher income are encouraged to apply because certain deductions are given. MBIWD enrollees with income greater than 150% FPL are required to pay a premium.

The resource limit for all MPAP categories is \$4,000 (individual) and \$6,000 (couple).
